Limitation of use

The jacket (1410F34) and pants (1410F35) must always be worn together. The coat (1410113), hood (1410155), apron (1410033) and gaiters (1410003) must be worn with a complete protection according to the standard EN ISO 11612 to improve safety measures. Protection against the risks indicated in this informative note is not guaranteed if the pieces are used individually. The garments only protect the part of the body actually covered; therefore they must be integrated, according to the use, with the relevant PPEs to protect hands, feet and head. The safety features indicated are guaranteed only if the garments are of the right size, are correctly worn, buckled up, and in a perfect state of preservation. Before use, visually control everything to make sure the devices are in perfect conditions, are not broken and are clean; if the clothing should not be in perfect conditions (open seams, tears or holes) replace immediately; if there are any stains, follow the instructions in the MAINTENANCE paragraph. In case of accidental splashing of chemical or flammable liquids on any clothes, immediately move away from the operating area and remove the equipment, so the substance must not come into contact with skin. Clothes should be subjected to a wash. The flame propagation limitation feature may be jeopardized if the devices are contaminated with flammable products. The isolating effects of the equipment may be damaged with water, humidity or sweat. In case of jets of melted metals, the user has to leave at once places and to remove the garment. The manufacturer cannot be held responsible for any damages or consequences resulting from an incorrect use, or from tampering with the devices.
